Clean and safe cooking for Nigerian families

For many families in Nigeria, irritating smoke that makes it difficult to breathe has now come to an end. 87 percent of the population have no access to clean cooking facilities and cook on open fires, producing harmful smoke and CO₂ emissions.

It is mostly women who cook and are the driving force in this climate project, which provides improved cookstoves to households and small businesses. The efficient stoves produce less smoke, improve health, and save around 604,520 tonnes of CO₂ every year.
